

Special County Wide Election

Tuesday, May 2, 2017

A Special County Wide Election for Dallas County residents to vote on a new Law Enforcement Center will be held on Tuesday, May 2, 2017.

All eligible electors who live in Dallas County are eligible to vote.

An eligible elector must:

- Be a citizen of the United States
- Be a resident of Iowa
- Be at least 18 years old

An eligible elector must NOT:

- Be a convicted felon (unless voting rights have been restored by the president or governor)
- Be currently judged incompetent to vote by a court
- Claim the right to vote in any other place

WHAT WILL APPEAR ON THE BALLOT:

Shall the County of Dallas, State of Iowa, authorize a Loan Agreement and issue its General Obligation Capital Loan Notes in an amount not exceeding the amount of \$22,900,000 for the purpose of designing, constructing, erecting, equipping, and furnishing a new Law Enforcement Center, with related site improvements?
