Absentee Voting Begins for the Waukee Special School Election

Dallas County Auditor and Commissioner of Elections Julia Helm announced that absentee ballots for the February 6, 2018 Waukee Special School Election will be available to be voted in the Dallas County Auditor's Office & via mail beginning January 8, 2018.

Absentee ballots may be cast in the Dallas County Auditor's Office at 210 N 10th St., Adel, IA, during regular office hours from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday, until Monday, February 6, 2018 at 5:00 p.m.

Absentee ballots requests to be issued via mail also starts January 8th up until Friday at 5:00 p.m. on January 26, 2018.

Absentee ballots must be requested in writing. Forms are available at the Auditor's Office, on the Dallas County website at www.co.dallas.ia.us/government/auditor/elections, and the Iowa Secretary of State's website at www.sos.iowa.gov. Ballots returned through the mail must be postmarked by midnight, February 5, 2018. The Auditor encourages those returning their ballots via the postal service to mail them before February 5, 2018.
